



JORVIK Group COVID-19 Policy

Health advice relating to COVID-19 virus is being regularly revised by WHO and the Department of Health, and accordingly, our policies and advice relating to minimising risk of infection to staff, volunteers and visitors will be updated regularly to remain in line with national guidance.

As of 2nd March, 2020, the following prevention measures are in place at all JORVIK Group attractions:

- Alcohol-based hand gel, which will kill the virus on hands, will be available throughout all of our attractions, particular places where touch screens and interactive elements require visitors to touch. All visitors will be encouraged to use gel at frequent intervals.
- Staff and volunteers are fully briefed in precautions that they can take to minimise exposure, with appropriate hand washing and sanitisation equipment provided.
- Additional cleaning and disinfection regimes are in place for areas of our attractions regularly touched by visitors.
- Where pupils from any school are being tested for Covid-19 virus, particularly where pupils or their families have returned from high risk areas and are either showing cold/flu symptoms or otherwise advised to self-isolate, we will not accept visits from those groups until full clear test results have been received. Where possible, alternative dates for visits will be offered once the all-clear has been received.
